ABOUT-US:

To everyone considering the Minor Adjustments Discipleship House, my wife and I extend a heartfelt welcome. We recognize the weight of your decision to transition and the challenges that come with choosing the right residence. Our mission has been to create a Christcentered, family-oriented environment that blends the Minor Adjustments Workbook, the Life Recovery Workbook, ongoing discipleship, and a supportive home atmosphere into a meaningful and transformative experience.

The Minor Adjustments Discipleship House is to support a smooth and successful reintegration into society for individuals transitioning from drug rehabilitation centers or correctional institutions. While the house and its community do not provide treatment, clinical services, or detox, we do offer a strong foundation of support. This is cultivated through daily interactions, structured group meetings, and mandatory morning devotions that reinforce sobriety, accountability, and ongoing recovery.

PAYMENTS:

Once employed, residents are expected to contribute a house-share donation of \$125 per week, due every Friday by 10:00 p.m., submitted to the Director or their designated representative. Residents are responsible for purchasing their own food, toiletries, and personal care items. All household utilities are covered by the ministry.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

To apply, please contact our office at 1-888-233-3299 to schedule an interview, which can be conducted in person, by phone, or via Zoom. Applications may also be submitted through our website. The interview helps us assess your readiness and determine whether the Minor Adjustments Program is the right fit for your needs.



REQUIREMENTS (MANDATORY)

- Attend Minor Adjustments Program (1x a Week).
- All residents must attend Recovery/Community support meetings
- Submit to random Drug/Alcohol testing.
- Weekly Worship Service - Attending Sunday worship at an approved church home.
- Be considerate and respectful to other residents.
- Do daily chore and Keep personal area clean.
- Attend house meetings, Abide by curfew
- Make a commitment to stay clean and sober.
- Smoking, vaping, and all forms of tobacco use are strictly prohibited.
